New Covid protocols

We require all patients (unless medically exempt) to wear a mask when visiting the practice. This is for your safety as well as the safety of our staff and ourselves. The most recent study in December 2021 carried out by the CDC showed that mask wearing is effective. Until we are advised otherwise by our regulatory bodies and the science community, this practice policy will be upheld.

Please remember to use the motionactivated hand sanitiser at the front door when entering and leaving the practice.

If sent to you, please do fill in the medical forms online prior to your appointment as this reduces the risk of contamination of having to fill in a hard copy medical history form in reception.

We have increased the length of all our appointments to allow for extra cleaning time especially after AGPs (aerosol generating procedures) and ask that you inform us before your appointment if you are suffering from any covid symptoms (high temperature/persistent cough/ shortness of breath/loss of taste or smell/ tummy trouble/rashes) or have had a positive covid test.

Our hygiene appointments will now be: H30 £70: 30 minutes handscaling and polish; H45 £95: 45 minutes ultrasonic scaling and

polishing; H60 £160: 60 minutes deep clean with the ultrasonic scaler (local anaesthetic if necessary) and polishing. The cost of the appropriate PPE is included. Your dentist will advise which appointment you'll need based on your clinical requirement.

While we appreciate some patients need an accompanying adult/carer, in order to maintain some social distance, please attend only with the patients who have appointments booked to avoid crowding in the reception area.

Like us, we're sure you're all weary of this pandemic and we all look forward to the day when we can return to some semblance of normality, even though we know life will never be the same as it was before 2020. However, in the meantime, it is important we follow the protocols to allow us to continue to work in an environment that is safe for us, our staff and for you so we thank you for your compliance.

With all the changes, we thought it would be useful for our patients to have a written schedule of who is in surgery on any given day so you can plan your visits in advance if you wish to see a particular clinician.
